COVID-19: Founders Day Postponed and Mexico Cruise Canceled

As everyone is aware, we are dealing with extraordinary circumstances with regard to the COVID-19 novel coronavirus.

Last Friday, March 6th, the San Francisco Department of Public Health issued new recommendations to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus. This included a recommendation that individuals 60 years of age and older don't go to gatherings of about 50 people or more. You can read the recommendations here.

As a result of these recommendations, and out of an abundance of caution, MAX has decided to postpone the Founders Day event originally scheduled for this coming Sunday, March 15th.

We intend to hold the 2020 MAX Founders Day party later this year. Look for an announcement in a future issue of this newsletter. We will also contact everyone who had previously registered for the March 15th date.

In addition, the MAX Cruise to Mexico including the tour of Mexico's Guadalupe Valley wine region has also been canceled. While the cruise line, Carnival, still plans to proceed with this cruise, Carnival has offered a future cruise credit for the value of the cruise good through March 31, 2021, for all members of the MAX travel group who wish to cancel their cruise. MAX is also refunding to the participants the fees paid to MAX for organizing the trip. Many thanks to our travel host David Petlin for all his efforts on behalf of everyone who had booked this trip.

Our remaining events tend to be smaller than 50 people and offer an opportunity to get out and visit with other members of our community during this difficult time.

MAX was started during the AIDS crisis when just such opportunities to socialize were so badly needed.

These are difficult times and we encourage every member of the MAX community to use their own best judgment, in consultation with their physician, whether to attend any of our events.

Please do use appropriate precautions and your best judgement when at MAX events. The following is San Francisco Department of Public Health <u>recommendation</u> 7 that applies to everyone:

- The best way for all San Franciscans to reduce their risk of getting sick, as with seasonal colds or the flu, still applies to prevent COVID19:
 - Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
 - O Cover your cough or sneeze.
 - Stay home if you are sick.
 - Avoid touching your face

- Try alternatives to shaking hands, like an elbow bump or wave.
- If you have recently returned from a country, state or region with ongoing COVID-19 infections, monitor your health and follow the instructions of public health officials.
