For the second MAX virtual performing arts event, we're going to watch the New York Metropolitan Opera production of *The Exterminating Angel*.

The Exterminating Angel is a modern (2016) English-language opera by Thomas Adès.

Tom Cairns directs an engrossing and inventive production, using a towering wooden archway to trap the characters onstage. Adès himself takes the podium to conduct the frenzied score.
